## Contest Rules

Each contestant must bring a recipe to showcase what ingredients are in the entry and how it was made.

### Categories:

All (adults and children)

- **Main Dishes or Entress**
- **Open (Soups, Apetizers, etc.)**
- **Desserts**

Children (ages 5 - 16) will be entered in two categories — Main Dish and Dessert. There has been a decrease in participation (one in 2015 and 2016, none in 2017). These are eliminated and everyone will be lumped together.

The contestants filled in the entry sheets in order to reduce the questioning of the correct spelling — which had been an issue in the past.

### Prizes:

**Adults:** Medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each category

Monetary Prize for 1<sup>st</sup> place (\$25.00), 2<sup>nd</sup> place (\$15.00), and 3<sup>rd</sup> place (\$10.00)

**Children:** Ribbons for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each category

Monetary Prize for 1<sup>st</sup> place (\$25.00), 2<sup>nd</sup> place (\$15.00), and 3<sup>rd</sup> place (\$10.00)

**Best of Show:** Medal and Monetary Prize (\$25.00)

(This is judged from all 1st prize winners from each category)

### Judging and Scoring:

Each entry will be judged on four qualities: **EYE APPEAL**, **FLAVOR**, **TEXTURE** and **AUTHENTICITY**. Each quality is worth 10 points for at top score of 40 points. Therefore, each quality will be judged with a rating of 1-10 points and then added up for each category. A 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place are rewarded. The judges then gather together to judge best of show (all 1<sup>st</sup> place winning entries).
